Summer Undergraduate Fellowships in Genetics (SUNFIG)

Recommendation Instructions

Program Description

In this nine-week program, students will be matched with a faculty mentor in the Department of Genetics and be integrated into a lab research team. Research in the Genetics Department is vibrant and diverse – students can choose to work with a faculty mentor in areas related to molecular biology, functional genomics, biotechnology, developmental genetics, ecology, and/or evolution. The program requires a 40hr/week commitment for nine weeks. During this time, students will engage in an authentic research experience, from project design to data analysis and presentation. Our program also provides mentoring in professional development. The Genetics Department is committed cultivating a supportive environment to promote the success of all scholars and fostering the careers of developing scientists.

In what capacity do you know the applicant and how long have you known him/her?

What do you consider the applicant's strongest qualities and why?

What do you consider the applicant's weakest qualities and why?
